## **MEMORIAL AWARDS**

### **The Alexander and Brian Arredondo Brother Memorial Scholarship**

Alexander Scott Arredondo graduated from Blue Hills electrical program in 2002. His fellow classmates and teachers all remember him as friendly and conscientious. He was also awarded the Quinn award. Alex joined the United States Marine Corps upon graduation and served two tours in Iraq. He was killed in action on August 25, 2004 during the siege of Najaf at the age of 20.

Brian Luis Arredondo was Alex's younger brother, three years his junior. Many family members were adversely impacted by Alex's death and Brian suffered greatly. Despite many attempts to aid Brian by family members, Brian took his own life in late 2011 at the age of 24. This joint scholarship is set up to remember both a fine Marine and the impact that grief and loss has on surviving family members, especially siblings.
